

Mini Quilt Challenge 2019
For SCIQ Members which will be used as a Group Entry for Maine Quilts 2019

Challenge: Make a wall hanging/ mini quilt with your interpretation of Maine Quilts Challenge Theme: “Buoy o Buoy!” by incorporating a visible piece of Kathy Hatch’s “Seafood Shack” for Northcott on the front side of the challenge.

**It must also include some form of embellishment.
It must be a quilted challenge; no dioramas.**

The total outer dimension must be a minimum of 42 inches and no greater than 70 inches.

The wall hanging/ mini quilt must be made by the person entering the challenge (including the quilting).

You may hand piece, machine piece or paper piece.

You may appliqué by hand or by machine.

You may machine or hand quilt.

You must meet the deadlines established by the chapter challenge in order for us to be able to meet the deadlines for Maine Quilts 2019.

Pine Tree Quilters Guild has established several ground rules for chapter challenges; therefore, you must abide by these as well.

Your entry in this group mini-quilt challenge counts towards the individual’s maximum number of quilt entries. For 2019, Pine Tree limit is four per individual; therefore, if you enter this challenge, you will only be permitted to enter another 3 quilts in the show.

Permission for display at Maine Quilts is required for any challenge entry that is neither original nor traditional. It is best to seek permission before you begin. Otherwise, you may complete the challenge only to find out you are unable to display your work if permission is not secured.

Maine Quilts has a “Blanket Permission” list of designers/publishers who have already granted permission. It has been published in Patchwork Press and is available online.

Forms:

There is a special registration form to fill out for a challenge entry. Your completed entry form must be given to Carmelle Garant no later than April 24, 2019 (this is the date of our monthly business meeting). Lynda Duplissea and Carmelle Garant will compile the forms and complete the registration process with Maine Quilts.

Finished Mini Quilt/ Wall hanging must be turned into Carmelle Garant and Lynda Duplissea no later than June 19, 2019. This is our monthly business meeting.
