Supplies

“Caddy Pad,” Caddy Pad Jr.” or “Travel Iron Tote” patterns, all designed by Sisters’ Common Thread can be purchased at Amazon and Etsy as well as other retailers.

With Heat-Resistant Lining



Heat resistant fabric included

Materials Required: (*Caddy Pad, Jr. and Travel Iron Tote in ()*)

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|---------------------------|--|
| 21” x 28” (14 ½” x 17 ½”) | Cut 1 of Main Fabric (preshrunk) for Caddy Body |
| 4” x 14” (2 ¼ “ x 9 ½ “) | Cut 2 pieces of Contrasting Fabric for handles |
| 21” x 28” (14 ½” x 17 ½”) | Cut 1 Heat Resistant Ironing Board Fabric |
| 21” x 28” (14 ½” x 17 ½”) | Cut 2 layers of Insul-Bright® OR 2 layers of Cotton batting pieces (preshrunk) OR 1 layer of Warm Tater® |
| 1” or larger | 2 pretty buttons--shank buttons work well |
| 9” (6”) | ¼” wide elastic or elastic hair ties |
| ¼ yard | Contrasting fabric to make about 90” (65”) of binding. Usually cut to be 2 ¼” to 2 ½” wide |

Tools Needed

Sewing machine, cord and foot pedal, extension cord and machine manual

Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler

Matching thread

Scissors, seam ripper, and other sewing supplies

Sharp pencil, a mechanical pencil works well for this step

Eraser

Iron and pad (every 4th person)
