Designed by Vendulka Battais, this chevron table runner is easy to make and is a good beginner quilting project. The pattern is the perfect quilting project for showcasing a large fabric print in the center.

Approx. size 17 ½" x 46"

**FABRICS AND CUTTING HOMEWORK:**

Focus fabric for center      CUT    (1) 10" square

(1) 2 ½" strip from EACH of five different fabrics:

CUT    (1) 2 ½" x width of fabric strip from each fabric  
 SUBCUT each into (4) 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips

(1) 2 ½" strip for accent squares—make sure there is a good contrast between this and the other strips:

CUT    (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip  
 SUBCUT into (10) 2 ½" squares

¼ yd. border

CUT    (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" strip  
           (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strip  
           (2) 2 ½" x WOF strip—length to be determined later

¼ yd. binding

CUT    (3) 2 ¼" or 2 ½" x WOF strips

1 yard backing

CUT    20" x 50"—may be pieced, if necessary

Batting

CUT    20" x 50"

**SUPPLIES:**

Fabric as listed above and any leftover fabric

Sewing machine, cord and foot pedal, extension cord and machine manual

Thread to match

Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler

Scissors, seam ripper, and other sewing supplies

Iron and pad (every 4<sup>th</sup> person)
