Supply List

- Fabric scraps – light, medium, and dark
- Add-a-Quarter 6 inch ruler for paper piecing
- Postcard, Tweezers
- Open-toe pressure foot
- Sewing Machine and manual
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, quilting rulers
- Iron and pressing pad
- A few flower head pins and other straight pins with small heads
- New machine needles
