This workshop will cover the topics of how to:

- Measure border strips so that your quilt will not have wavy borders
- Calculate length of binding
- Trim quilt before adding borders
- Cut and join binding strips
- Sew perfect corners
- Joining ends of binding strips
- Blind stitch binding to back of quilt
- Cut bias binding

Fabric

- A current project that needs border strips and/or binding
OR
- A quilt sandwich (fabric-batting-fabric) for practice that is at least 15" square
- Fabric for binding and border, if needed
- Fabric to make bias binding – a piece of fabric that is 16" inches wide (selvage to selvage). About 16" X 40"

Supplies:

- Fabrics as listed above
- Matching thread
- Machine in good working order, cord, foot pedal, extension cord
- **1/4" presser foot, walking foot,**
- straight pins, scissors, seam ripper, basic sewing supplies
- Rotary cutter, mat board, 6 1/2" x 24 1/2" ruler, 12" x 12" ruler
- Fabric marker of your choice
- Iron and pad—every 4th person
- Snippet bag
