



Cutting Instructions – Do before workshop

Color A-Dark Background on edge and center

2 strips – 6 ½" x 22 ½"
2 strips – 5" x width
2 strips – 3 ½" x width
2 strips – 2" x 22 ½"

Color B-Red Accent color

1 strip – 2 ½" x 22 ½"
4 strips – 2" x 22 ½"
8 strips – 2" x width
One square – 7" x 7"

Color C-Medium blue color

1 strip – 8 ½" x 22 ½"
1 strip – 5 ½" x width
1 strip – 2 ½" x width

Color D-Light color

2 strips – 8" x 22 ½"
2 strips – 5" x width
2 strips – 2" x width

- Press fabric – use of spray starch or Magic Sizing is optional
- Square up/Straighten fabric – tips on YouTube, Craftsy, Missouri Star, etc.
- Cut strips across the full width of fabric. Strip width must be accurate.
- Measure with your acrylic ruler, not the cutting mat grid. The measuring grid on most cutting mats will not provide the accuracy you need for this project.

Label each strip set by width and color – Examples: 5" A, 8" D
