Designed by Deb Tucker for Studio 180 Design, Atlantic Flyway is named for the migratory path of waterfowl, shorebirds and songbirds of the North American East Coast.

Techniques include "Fast Flying Geese" with Wing Clipper I ruler, "Migrating Geese" for borders and a bit of paper piecing for tricky star points. A wonderful wall quilt (44" x 44") or start to a medallion style quilt.



FABRIC: (no cutting at home)

- 1 ½ yards Light background
- ¼ yard Inner Border
- 1 ¼ yards Outer Border and Binding
- 1 ½ yards Equivalent of scraps for geese and stars
- 3 yards Backing

SUPPLIES NEEDED FROM STUDIO 180 DESIGN: (or other quilt shops)

Atlantic Flyway Pattern, \$11.50

Wing Clipper I Tool, \$22.50 (*perhaps several friends could share one*)

Quilter's Magic Wand, \$5.95 *or other tool to mark ¼" seam allowances on both side of center line*

YOUR SUPPLIES:

- Fabric as listed above and any leftover fabric
- Sewing machine, cord and foot pedal, extension cord and machine manual
- Thread to match
- Mechanical pencil to mark sewing lines
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler
- Scissors, seam ripper, and other sewing supplies
- Iron and pad (every 4th person)
- Bag lunch for Saturday workshop
