# Handy Mason Jar Pincushion Workshop

Customize the contents and fabric selection to match the interest of the person to receive this useful and thoughtful gift.

## Supply List

For this workshop, you will NOT need to bring a sewing machine or rotary cutting supplies.

For the flower on the ribbon, you will need a scrap of blue tonal (or fabric of your choice) for the yo-yo and a piece of black and white check (or fabric of your choice) plus a button to cover. Another option is to use a regular button of your choice.

7" square multicolored print fabric of your choice

12" x  $\frac{5}{8}$ " piece of coordinating satin ribbon

Wide-mouthed Mason canning jar of desired size with screw cap and separating lid. The one in the illustration is a  $\frac{1}{2}$  pint size. If you would like to order one this size from Joanne, just let her know in advance. The cost is \$2.

Basic sewing tools: hand sewing needle, matching thread, fabric scissors, and paper scissors

Joanne will provide:

- Scrap of cardstock
- Fiberfill to create a pincushion on the top of the jar
- Hot glue gun and glue
