This quilt is super easy to make. If you can sew a 4-patch, you can make this quilt. Lots of color suggestions are included on page 2. A collection of 6 1/2" squares is combined with a light and a dark accent to set the stage for a wonderful performance. The pattern includes instructions for: Crib, Throw, Twin/Full, Queen and King.

FABRICS: (FQ – Fat Quarter 18" x 22")

	Crib 44" x 59"	Throw 59" x 74"	Twin/Full 74" x 89"	Queen 89" x 104"	King 104" x 104"
Center Squares (see above)	(4) 1/4 yd. cuts OR (4) FQs	(8) 1/4 yd. cuts OR (8) FQs	(14) 1/4 yd. cuts OR (14) FQs	(20) 1/4 yd. cuts OR (20) FQs	(24) 1/4 yd. cuts OR (24) FQs
#1 Dark Border Fabric	1/2 yd.	5/8 yd.	3/4 yd.	1 yd.	1 yd.
#2 Chain/Cornerstones	1/2 yd.	3/4 yd.	1 yd.	1 1/4 yd.	1 1/2 yd.
#3 Light background	1 1/2 yds.	2 1/4 yds.	3 yds.	4 yds.	4 1/2 yds.
Backing	3 yds.	3 3/4 yds.	5 1/2 yds.	8 yds.	9 1/4 yds.
Binding	1/2 yd.	2/3 yd.	3/4 yd.	7/8 yd.	1 yd.

There are cutting instructions inside the pattern if you would like to cut your fabric at home prior to the workshop.
