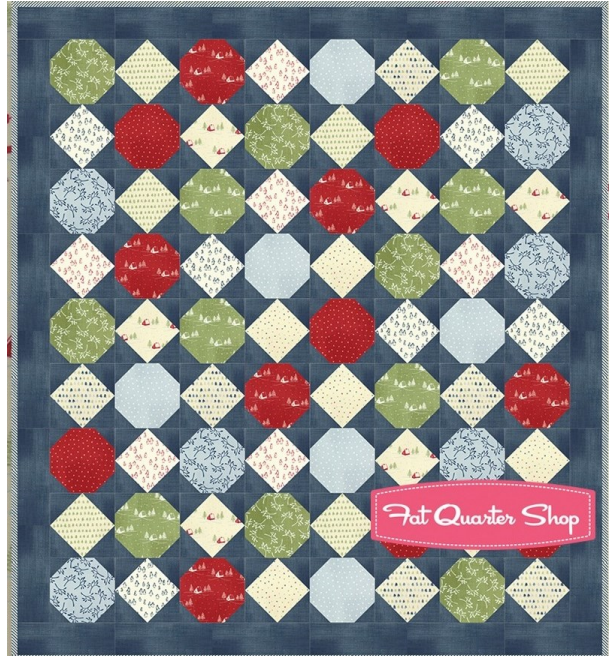


St. Croix International Quilters

Fat Quarters Snowballs Workshop

It's a winter wonderland. This quilt is a variation of the traditional snowball pattern and is easily made using the *Mini Simple Folding Corners Ruler*. You won't want to miss learning this new technique.

Also available is the complete quilt kit that is available from www.fatquartershop.com; it includes Fat Quarter Snowballs Quilt Pattern, Wintertide fabric for the 50" x 55.5" quilt top and binding.

FABRICS AND CUTTING HOMEWORK:

(6) dark fat quarters (18" x 20"-22") each one a different print/texture
CUT each fat quarter into (6) 6" squares

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2 ¼ yds. dark background—make sure it contrasts well with dark fat quarters above
CUT (144) 3 ¼" squares
(144) 2" squares

5/8 yd. binding—to be cut later

3 2/3 yds. backing—to be pieced later

SUPPLIES:

Fabric as listed above and any leftover fabric

Directions for the project will be shared at the workshop

Mini Simple Folded Corners Ruler (#AQDR2) available from www.fatquartershop.com, \$10.98 + shipping

Sewing machine, cord and foot pedal, extension cord and machine manual

Thread to match

Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler

Scissors, seam ripper, and other sewing supplies

Iron and pad (every 4th person)
