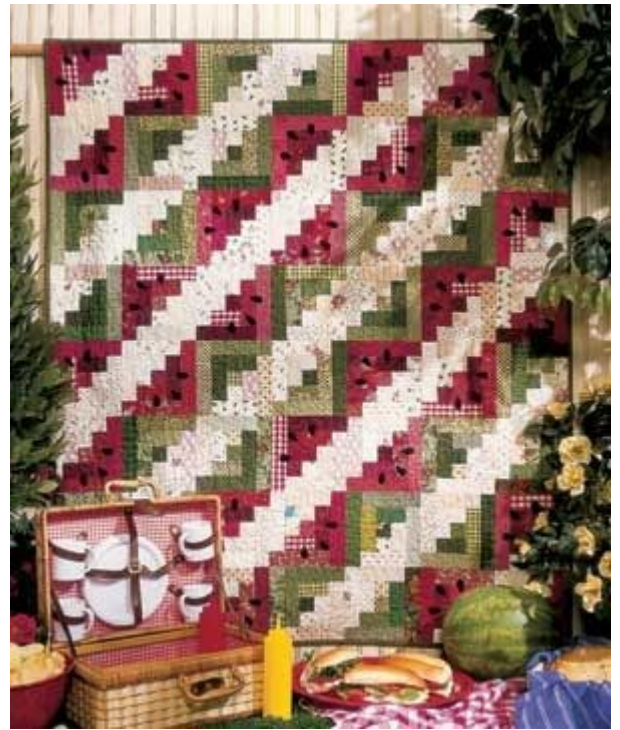

# Watermelon Picnic Workshop

*Watermelon Picnic* is a fun-loving quilt perfect for a sunny afternoon picnic! This easy scrap quilt by Teri Christopherson features simple log cabin blocks with appliqued seeds for a sweet finishing touch. Quilt finishes to approximately 53" x 60". Not a watermelon fan? Choose to make a traditional log cabin quilt, if you would rather.

Come to the workshop prepared to have lots of watermelon fun. Door prizes, too! In addition, for every log cabin block you make at the workshop, you get a chance to win a picnic basket similar to the one shown here.

## **FABRICS:**

### If using watermelon-colored scraps:

1 ½ yds. total of assorted ivory prints  
1 yd. total of assorted red prints and gingham  
1 yd. total of assorted green prints and checks  
¼ yd. black solid for watermelon seeds  
½ yd. dark green for binding  
3 ¼ yds. fabric for backing  
57" x 64" piece of batting  
⅓ yd. fusible web (17" wide)

### If using scraps for a traditional log cabin quilt:

1 ½ yds. total of assorted light prints  
2 yds. total of assorted medium to dark prints  
¼ yd. red solids/tone-on-tone, the traditional color  
for block centers  
½ yd. fabric of your choice binding  
3 ¼ yds. fabric for backing  
57" x 64" piece of batting

Detailed cutting directions are included in the pattern. Make sure you cut and sort strips at home prior to the workshop.

## **SUPPLIES:**

Fabric as listed above and any leftover fabric

Sewing machine, cord and foot pedal, extension cord and machine manual

Thread to match

Cutting mat, rotary cutter, and ruler

Scissors, seam ripper, and other sewing supplies

Iron and pad (every 4<sup>th</sup> person)

Picnic lunch for yourself; fresh watermelon available for everyone
