Business Meeting May 20, 2015

President Sue McIver called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Guest Deb. Welcome back to Lynda Duplissea. During roll call each participant told the group what projects they have lined up for the summer. There were 36 people present.

Jane Eaton read the minutes of the April meeting which were approved as read. Total in treasury: \$2829. + according to Mary Ann O'Brien, treasurer.

Mary Louise Peters and Liz Trouant summarized upcoming Saturday and Wednesday workshops. There workshops are described on the website.

Betsy Dorr from Quiltessentials in Auburn learned that she will be featured in Quilt Sampler magazine. This is a big honor.

Joline reported that membership stands at 87.

Lynda Duplissea reported for Publicity that she has sent a report to the Patchwork Press. She also wrote an article for a Canadian quilting magazine.

Wanda has 20 quilts for hospice and expects to have 25 to 30 quilts to present next month.

Nominating committee, by Mary Ann O'Brien chairperson, reports that Susan wants to do another term as president and Beverli McAdam will do 2nd vice president. There were other names put forward.

Lynda Duplissea moved and Maxine seconded that we spend about \$63 for 15 yards of 90 inch wide muslin to be used for hospice quilt backing.

Anita Johnson did the 2 minute tip, demonstrating how she uses hangers to keep finished blocks together. Hanging up blocks saves on ironing. She also hangs, on skirt or slacks hangers, pieces of fabric she is reserving for a certain quilt which is in process (so she doesn't use that fabric for something else).

Joline Cook demonstrated how to make a quilt wrap.

Peggy Brownlee won the fabric draw.
There were 16 showing their work at Show and Tell.
