

St. Croix International Quilters Meeting

Feb. 19, 2020

The meeting was called to order with Vice President Joline Cook presiding and 19 members present. Secretary's report was read with Jude motioning to accept report, Val seconded, all in favor. We had 2 correspondence letters. Joline read a letter from Bonnie and Wanda read a letter from the Machias Savings Bank. Val had a lovely card embroidered for the Machias Saving Bank thanking them for our \$500 grant for Hospice which all members attending this meeting signed. Julie is going to mail card to the Machias office. Treasurer's report was given with \$1229.09 in Hospice, \$97.03 in Education, \$257 in raffle quilt, and \$1090.22 in general fund giving a total of \$2673.32 in Treasurer's account.

Old Business: Sue read results of survey about the quilt show she had given out. The Congressional Church is being turned over to Sunrise Opportunities so we are still looking for a venue for the quilt show. A motion was made by Liz to use paper ballots to do voting with DeeDee seconding, all in favor. I made a motion to put the quilt show off for at least a year, Val seconded, paper vote was taken for this motion and the show was voted to be put off for at least a year. Mary Ann read an old patchwork press article from 2001. Sewing classes for Grades 4-6, unless someone younger from last year wants to sew, also will be starting on Tuesday Mar. 2 at 2:30 to 4:30 for 6 weeks. Summer class will be starting June 22 from 8-12 for 1 week. Patty H. and Jane are going to help Jude.

New Business: Positions that need to be filled- President, we have 1 volunteer for this position, Sue McIver. Val motioned to accept Sue for this position, Marlene seconded all in favor, and Sue is our new

President. Quilt Show Treasurer needs to be replaced also, this was discussed, Sue made a motion to put this money all under the umbrella of our Treasurer, one account with her keeping this total separate on her books, Val seconded, all in favor. Someone needs to take care of Raffle Quilt, find venues to sell tickets at and get tickets ready for each member to sell. Shari Doten will house the quilt at Armetis' Attic again this year for us. Lynda D. will take quilt and rack there and get it set up. Webmaster has a volunteer of Jude Clark (nanajude51@gmail.com). Jude mentioned that site needed to be renewed and gave us the prices of \$215.64 for 3 years and \$359.40 for 5 years. Julie motioned to go with the 3 year term, Mary Louise seconded, all in favor. We still need a fundraising chairperson so being thinking of this please.
